Epitomized Map of New England in 17th Century

This map shows the year 1675 during The King Philip Wars. In different colors the seven governments are distinctly shown, along with “that” government’s population. One distinct feature of this map is that Massachusetts has the leading population of 25,000 people. Another feature is that the settlement of Brookfield and Springfield lie a great distance away from all of the major settlements like Boston and Charlestown. This map shows where the Indian tribes were and which tribe settled where. The last major feature to this map is the gaps of territory between the governments of Connecticut and New Haven.
