Western 1831 (Topographic and Roads Details)

Map 11 illustrates the town of Western in 1831, created because the General Court ordered a survey from all of the towns to construct a detailed map of their own town. Some maps created were more detailed than others, but this map shows the boundary lines, topography, roads and rivers of Western, which we now know as Warren. The color green represents hills or higher elevations and the color brown represents meadows and lower elevations. Also labeled on this map are the surrounding towns of Brookfield, Ware, Palmer, and Brimfield.

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
