Brookfield Massacre in 1693, with Grants and Home Sites

Map 24 illustrates the Brookfield Massacre that occurred in 1693. Indians originally from Canada traveled to Brookfield. These Canadian Indians engaged in a rampage and set off through Brookfield brutally killing and capturing many innocent citizens. The last citizens to be killed by the Canadian Indians in Brookfield were haymakers in 1710. On this map you are shown the citizens who were killed or held captive, with the location in which they lived and also their land acreage. Another feature to this map is it shows Elm Hill Farm Road or the Old Post Road labeled in the center of the map.
