Tectonic Plate Movements—Present and 250 Million Years Into the Future

Map 30 is very unique. With the flap down, you will see the present-day continental layout with the present-day tectonic plate locations. The boundaries of the tectonic plates are labeled with a gold line. The arrows on the gold line illustrate the tectonic plates' direction of travel. After about 250 million years you will find a much different continental layout (*Found under the flap*). You will see the continents crash together in a donut-like shape, with Australia and Antarctica joined together. You will also find very high altitude mountains where the continents collided because of the amazing force that ripples and crunches the land.

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
