Original Quaboag Plantation – 1675 – New, Corrected Version

Map 34 demonstrates the original Quaboag Plantation in 1675, showing the sixteen plots of land with acreage as well as the people who occupied the land and the people who died there between 1665 and 1675. The Quaboag Plantation was the first settlement in Brookfield. This map spans from the west at Foster Hill to the east around Devil's Elbow Road. A unique feature is the illustration of Ayres's tavern where an attack occurred between the Indians and the English (*Demonstrated on map 23*). Lastly, Map 34 illustrates terrain such as roads, hills, marshes, and rivers.
