This map shows the way Central Brookfield was laid out in 1830. As you can see this

map displays the location of important historical buildings like the school, Unitarian

Church (which was the Old Meeting House), taverns and various other buildings and

houses. Also shown are roads leading from Brookfield to North Brookfield, Sturbridge,

Charlton and Worcester. In the right corner there is a section that leads to West

Brookfield and Springfield. Also shows Foster Hill Road. Today Charlton Road is called

Mill Street, the road to Sturbridge is called Fiskdale Road/Route 148 and there is a road

that cuts from Old Post Road to the stage road to Worcester, which is called Route 9.
