Brookfield Center Village – 1902 – 1911 (With Buildings Lost to Fire January 1902).

This map illustrates Brookfield Center Village between 1902 and 1911; it labels buildings and houses lost to fire with pink. One of the largest changes to the town was the fire in 1902. Just off of Prouty Street you will see a cluster of buildings. The buildings surrounded by the red border all burnt to the ground on January 24, 1902. These buildings are labeled with numbers corresponding to the numbered description box above. These buildings were never reconstructed. Another change was the fire that burnt down the original three story wooden Town Hall in 1902. This Town Hall was reconstructed out of brick, which is still the Town Hall today. Also shown on this map are the various businesses and homes with owners at the time and the location of where Route 9 lies today.

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
