

Map 42

Warren Center Village – 1911.

Map number 42 illustrates Warren, Massachusetts in 1911. This map mainly describes how Warren tamed the Quaboag River by using a dam. In the center of the map you will see a bridge and a dam. This dam tamed the wide Quaboag River and funneled it to create a more narrow and powerful stream to produce more power for the surrounding mills. This map also shows the location of houses with the name of residence. Also labeled are roads such as the Post Road and East Main Street as well as the town hall and other places of importance labeled with red stripe or black stripes.

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
