

## **Map 48**

### **Boundaries of the Original Quaboag Plantation (Overlapping 21<sup>st</sup> Century Various Town Boundaries)**

Map 48 illustrates the Quaboag Plantation plot of 1665. The outer perimeter of the Quaboag plantation is labeled with a green line. The total area of the plantation plot is 36 square miles. This is the land that appears in the Deed in 1665. This Deed is demonstrated in Map 49. The pink line demonstrates the town boundaries within this green 36 square mile designated land. Labeling present boundaries of Brookfield, East Brookfield, and West Brookfield. The big orange C's represents the location of center village in each given town. The gray circle labeled Q1 demonstrates the Western half of Quaboag settlement with meetinghouse and ten families in 1675. The gray circle labeled Q2 demonstrates the Eastern part of Quaboag settlement with four families. Q2 is located in the proximity of Devil's Elbow. Also illustrated are primary waterways.

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
