Deed to Map 48, Including Misc. Native Indian Information

Map 49 demonstrates the deed Lieutenant Cooper of Springfield created to purchase the Quaboag Plantation from the Shattoockquis. The text you see is the exact same spelling and grammar used in the original copy of this deed in 1665. This deed mainly explains the rights, descriptions, price, and new ownership of this land. On the right side of the deed you will find the mark of Shattoockuis and the mark of Metlawamppe. These are the consenting signatures by the Indians who sold the plantation. The plantation sold for 300 fathoms. In the bottom right of this deed you will find miscellaneous information about the Indians including: Indian populations and Destruction of the Massachusetts Tribe in 1660 and more. The illustration of the land sold in the deed is represented on map 48.
