Land Grants, North Brookfield and East Brookfield 1660-1800

This map displays various land grants and the details involved with each land grant. With the large overlay down you can see the housing population prior to 1749. In total there were 69 houses in North Brookfield and East Brookfield. Labeled between each of the circles is the number of houses between that circle and the next largest circle.

This map also displays hills and rivers. The rivers have little breaks in them, with labels for mill seats. If you look in the right hand bottom corner of this map you will see a little pond called Lashaway. When you flip over the little overlay you see the present day Lake Lashaway. This huge increase in volume was created from a dam constructed for a mill.
